Overview

- This is a Partisan Primary election. You may only vote within one political party. You will be able to vote in non-partisan contests.
- Offices include U.S. Senate seat, House of Representatives seat, local offices
- Two constitutional amendments will also appear on the ballot As with all Wisconsin elections, all voters must provide a Proof of Residence document when registering to vote by mail, in-person in the clerk's office, or at the polls on Election

July 30, 2024, possibly through August 11, 2024	Deadline for In-Person Absentee This varies by municipality so check with your local clerk's office to see what office hours may be available. Check MyVote or contact your municipal clerk for absentee voting hours.
August 13, 2024	 @ 5:00 p.m Deadline for Hospitalized Voters Hospitalized electors may request an absentee ballot between August 6, 2024, and August 13, 2024, at 5:00 p.m. @ 5:00 p.m Deadline to Request an Absentee Ballot @ 8:00 p.m Deadline to Return Absentee Ballot-
